Number of Positions: 30

Positions available: There are 30 job openings for the 2018 Summer season. Front desk, pool attendant, bus person, housekeeping, bell service and cooks are amongst the listed positions.

Hiring preferences: All jobs require customer service skills, motivation and a good level of conversational English. In certain position such as, excellent English levels are required. Energy is also a must. Exchange visitors are expected to make real connections with guest. Couples need not apply for housing reasons.

Arrival Dates: Earliest preferred arrival date is May 15th, 2018. The latest preferred arrival date is June 15th, 2018.

Departure dates: Earliest preferred departure date is August 15th, 2018. The latest departure date is October 15th, 2018

Positions descriptions:

18 Housekeeper \$10: Making beds, cleaning bedrooms, bathrooms, emptying garbage, sweeping, vacuuming and mopping floors and common areas. Laundry, washing, drying, folding and ironing of sheets and towels, supplying rooms with toiletries and accessories etc.

1 Front Desk \$10: Front Desk positions are responsible for displaying a professional, pleasant attitude to all customers. Job duties include greeting guests, taking reservations, checking people in and out, helping guest with problems, answering phones, handling U.S. currency, and general office help. This position requires excellent skills in English. This position will provide the opportunity to work directly with the public and gain skills in American customer service.

3 Food Runner/ Bus Person \$9: Responsible for washing and re-shelving dishware and glassware, emptying garbage, sweeping and mopping floors, wiping down food service tables, Bus Persons are responsible for assisting the wait staff, bringing water to the tables, clearing tables, taking out the garbage, helping to set the tables in the dining area, bringing dishes back and forth from the kitchen and generally keeping the dining room clean. Food and Beverage Assistants are responsible for waiting on customers, answering customer questions, setting up and clearing tables, and assisting servers.

3 Pool Attendant \$9.5: Pool Attendants help to keep the pool areas safe and clean. Job duties may include but are not limited mopping floors, cleaning bathrooms and showers, replacing towels, removing trash and enforcing facility rules and gate control. Also collecting towels for laundry service. You may be asked to help assist guests using the locker room. You should also be prepared to help out where needed and in general help keep the resort clean and running smoothly.

3 Bell person \$5.5 plus Tips: Attendants will be responsible for greeting and assisting customers at the door upon arrival, entrances, exits and departures. Bell persons assist guests with questions, information, packages, luggage and taxi cabs, tracking and directing visitors, and maintaining a neat area.

2 Cook/ breakfast attendant \$10: Cooks are responsible for preparing and cooking food orders per recipe guidelines. Cooks prepare batters, meat dishes and vegetables. Cooks provide back up to the line during busy hours, including restocking and maintaining workstations to assure plenty of product is always available. Cooks clean all workstations at the end of the day, sweeping and mopping of floors, emptying garbage, wiping down food service tables, cleaning appliances, chopping vegetables. The kitchen area at times may have high humidity and temperatures.

Work Hours: 32 hours per week

Uniforms: There are different uniforms for each department. Uniforms must be returned before the last paycheck for them to be free.

Housing information: Dorm style housing. Rent is \$100.00 per week per student. 2 Dorm style housing types: 2 Bedroom apartments with 2 full Bath, kitchen, living room, and patio. Each apartment has 3 bunk beds in each room for 6 people in a room. The houses are spacious and provide plenty of room for everyone. Total of 12 or 16 in each housing. Each housing has a common area and full kitchen. Men and women are in separate housing. 4 bedroom apartment has 3 full baths and there are 4 people to a room.

Rent is all inclusive of water, electric, wifi, cable, tv in common area of house, coin laundry facility on property. Full kitchens but cookware will not be included. Housing provide plates, cups, minor kitchen tools, appliances, etc., Iron/ironing board. Bed with mattress. Pillow, comforter, sheet set, and 2 towels, 2 washcloths, and 1 hand towel. Deposit is 200.00 and 80.00 is non refundable. This covers cleaning, and various damages incurred. 120.00 is refundable upon check out if the apartment is clean and no damages. In the lease there will be a price list of incurred damages. The deposit cannot be used toward last week of rent. Deposit must be paid prior to arrival.



Area Information: Pigeon Forge is a lively mountain resort city with many businesses, activities and entertainment facilities. It is also directly next to Gatlinburg and the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. With it's many attractions, it is an important tourism destination in Tennessee. It is a great destination to spend your work and travel program if you are into nature but also wanting to experience southern lifestyle, Pigeon Forge is a great city to discover American culture and its countryside.
