Job Description:

Housekeepers/Room Attendant: Must provide clean, sanitary, comfortable, orderly and satisfying guest rooms for the people visiting the resort. The housekeeper must be pleasant, friendly, and able to address problems and special requests. She/he may be required to perform tasks, which involve exposure to visible blood contamination. The housekeeper must follow the required procedures for handling, cleaning, disposing, or moving of objects/materials and/or the clean- up of blood, infectious materials, or body fluids containing blood in accordance with the OSHA Blood-borne Pathogen Standards.

LifeGuard: The lifeguard is responsible for ensuring the safety of facility patrons by preventing and responding to emergencies. Lifeguards must be Red Cross Certified or be able to pass the certification test given by Mt Olympus. Work will be both outside and inside. This position reports to the lead guard, lifeguard supervisor, assistant water/theme park manager, maintenance director, aquatics director, general manager, and owners.

Ride Attendant: Under general supervision, Ride Operator is responsible for the proper operation of amusement rides and attractions including assisting guests in loading and unloading of ride and restraining systems operating the ride using control panels, communicating safety instructions, and observing the ride while in motion in accordance with Mt. Olympus's Policies and Procedures. The Ride Operator will also be enforcing all park policies and safety guidelines in accordance with Mt. Olympus's Policies and Procedures.

PM Runner: The P.M. Runner is responsible for all of the guest's requests that are communicated by the front desk staff after 4:00pm. They must keep all hallways clean and clear. They supply the swimming pool and Waterpark with clean pool towels and remove all dirty ones. This position reports to the Night Housekeeping Manager.

Other Requirements: Must always bring a smile to work. Must be able to maintain and present a professional attitude and appearance at all times. Must possess excellent time management skills. Must be on time for work. Must be detail-oriented. Must be able to follow instructions. Must have good communication skills. Must be able to lift up to 50 lbs., bend, stoop and kneel.

English Requirement: Strong English

Work Dates:

- Arrival Dates – May 1st to June 25th
- End Dates – September 3rd to September 30th

Male/Female, Couples, Friend Groups: Couples ok, friend groups ok, as long as they all pass the interview. Expecting to hire half female and half male.

Work Hours: Room Attendants, Hotel General Cleaners, Houseperson: You should expect to work 32 hours per week.

Hiawatha requires the \$300 deposit and first 2 weeks of rent upon arrival. They return \$250 of the deposit as long as room is in good condition and rules haven't been broken. Linens are included.

Top Secret and Cabins (MTO) requires \$300 upon arrival. Rent is payroll deducted. We return all of the deposit as long as the housing contract hasn't been broken, the room is in good condition and no rules have been broken. Linens are also included.

Uniform Description:

Uniform prices vary depending on job position, see position description for more details. Mt. Olympus provides uniform shirt. Uniform shirt is payroll deducted.

Employees are required to provide their own black pants, shoes and socks.
Lifeguards get complete uniform, payroll deducted. Guards must provide their own water shoe.
