Positions: **Lifeguard (1)**

The primary responsibilities and duties of the lifeguards consist of, but are not limited to, the following:

▲Preventing aquatics emergencies

▲Performing rescues

▲Providing emergency care

▲Maintaining high standards of safety

▲Maintaining skills at a rescue-ready level at all times

▲Assisting with various tasks including but not limited to tubes, line control and cleanliness

▲Requires physical stamina, climbing stairs and extended periods of time in and out of chlorinated water in various weather conditions and temperatures; including working the sun for long hours during their shift.

▲Team Members must be willing to accept the responsibilities of working with the public, as they will be working directly with Park guests, including small children and their parents

Employer provides Ellis & Associates lifeguard certification at a facility nearby the property through a multi day class for certification. Transportation to training provided for free.

Lifeguards are paid \$9.00 per hour until they have successfully passed the Ellis & Associates lifeguard class. Once they have met the certification standards hourly wage is then paid at \$11.00 per hour.

Participants with lifeguard experience and CPR/First Aid certifications are encouraged to apply.

Prerequisites for lifeguard positions include:

Must be able to swim 200 yards consecutively using one of or a combination of the front crawl or breast stroke. Must be able to tread water without the use of hands for 2 minutes. Must be capable of surface diving to a depth of up to 10 feet to retrieve a 10 pound brick and return the brick to the surface.

Must have 20/25 or 20/25 corrected vision and agree to always wear corrective lens or lenses to assure 20/25 vision while on active-duty as a lifeguard.

- Wage: **\$11/hour**
- Housing: \$75/week

Participants will share park owned, fully furnished houses adjacent to the Park. Each participant

will share room, up to 2 per room, with separate beds.

PLEASE NOTE: Housing is to be assigned on availability at discretion of manager; friends and couples should not expect to live together as housing is divided strictly by gender.

First house has 1 bathroom and 2 bedrooms, a shared common room (with TV and cable) and shared kitchen (stocked with kitchenware). Second house is split into 2 apartments, each divided by gender. The larger apartment houses 5, the smaller apartment 4. Each apartment has 1 bathroom and 2 bedrooms, a shared common room (with TV and cable) and shared kitchen (stocked with kitchenware). Laundry facility on site, within walking distance from housing.

Participants are required to vacate the housing within 4 days of employment termination or ending employment.

Security deposit of \$500 is required upon arrival. Deposit is fully refunded if housing is left in the condition it was given and participants works through contracted date; an inspection is to be scheduled before departure.

PLEASE NOTE: Housing leases are secured for a period of time that matches each participant's program dates; participants are expected to stay in the housing for the duration of their program dates. Deposit may be forfeited if participants leave without the notice listed in the Housing Contract. Participants are required to vacate the housing within 4 days of employment termination or ending employment (quitting). Please see manager with any questions.

- Job benefits: 4 Free Canobie Lake Park admission tickets after July 4 th.
