Each participant will have their own bed. Utilities and WiFi included. Employer has arranged housing for participants and they should confirm their interest to utilize it during the interview.

Job description

Kitchen worker- Participants will be assisting cooks in preparing food and dishes that need to be served. Employees will also be washing dishes either using a dishwasher to clean plate and glassware or cleaning pots and pans by hand. Additionally, participants will be responsible for maintaining a clean workstation, assisting kitchen staff when required and assisting in overall kitchen cleanliness. This job requires standing for most of the shift so employees should be in good physical condition to stand for long periods of time. Participants will be using cleaning

chemicals. Participants will assist with prep of food items throughout shift. Great English communication is required for all kitchen staff. Starting wage is \$8.50 per hour. Once employees improve and become independent and proficient in their job responsibilities they will then receive a pay increase to \$9.50 per hour. This typically occurs after 2-3 weeks of work, depending upon performance, speed & accuracy. Excellent kitchen workers can earn up to \$10.50 per hour. All employees are also eligible for overtime hours up to a total of 50 hours per week.

Job description

Participants are not being hired into this role directly. Participants may be moved to this role after training or promoted to this role during the season. The decision to place participants in this role is based on their work performance and the employer's staffing needs. If participants are interested in this role, they should inform the employer during training. It is of the utmost importance that the individual that applies for this position have Excellent or fluent English. The position involves direct contact with the customer, so effective communication and understanding of the English language is the most important job qualification for the position. Duties will include direct, inperson communication with the customers and taking customer's food and drink orders in-person and over the telephone. The position also takes care of bar customers and carry-out orders. Employer prefers someone with an outgoing personality and serving experience. Waitstaff are in training for about 1-2 weeks, pay is \$7.25 per hour plus partial tips during that time. Once the participant has trained and is able to wait the tables independently they are given \$3.75 per hour plus the tips they earn. Once the participant is able to answer the phones and take carryout/delivery orders they are given an increase to \$5.00 an hour plus tips. If the individual does not earn enough in tips to get them to the minimum wage per hour worked the employer will make up the difference to the minimum wage. Participants that would like to earn more than 35-40 hours per week can have extra hours in the kitchen as an expediter at \$8.50 per hour. The average tips earned for a hard working well communicative participant is \$50-100 per shift plus hourly wage. Participants with Excellent verbal communication skills that have an out going personality succeed in this position. Must have the ability to multi task dine-in customers, carry-out and walk up counter.
